

Engineer or Surveyor - Licensure by Comity: A License as an Engineer or Professional Surveyor by comity will be granted provided the applicant is:

currently **licensed and in good standing with other NCEES** member Boards

meets all general requirements for licensure under MCA 73-13-23, which are:

Education

four (4) years or more in an engineering curriculum at a school or college approved by the board as of satisfactory standing or graduation in an engineering, engineering technology, or related science curriculum **OR**

four (4) scholastic years from a school or college other than those approved by the board plus a graduate degree in an engineering curriculum from a school or college wherein the same engineering curriculum at the undergraduate level is approved by the board as of satisfactory standing.

Experience

a specific record of four (4) years of qualifying engineering experience indicating that the applicant is competent to practice engineering (in counting years of experience, the board at its discretion may give credit not in excess of three (3) years for satisfactory graduate study in engineering),

Examinations

pass examinations in engineering as prescribed by the board.
